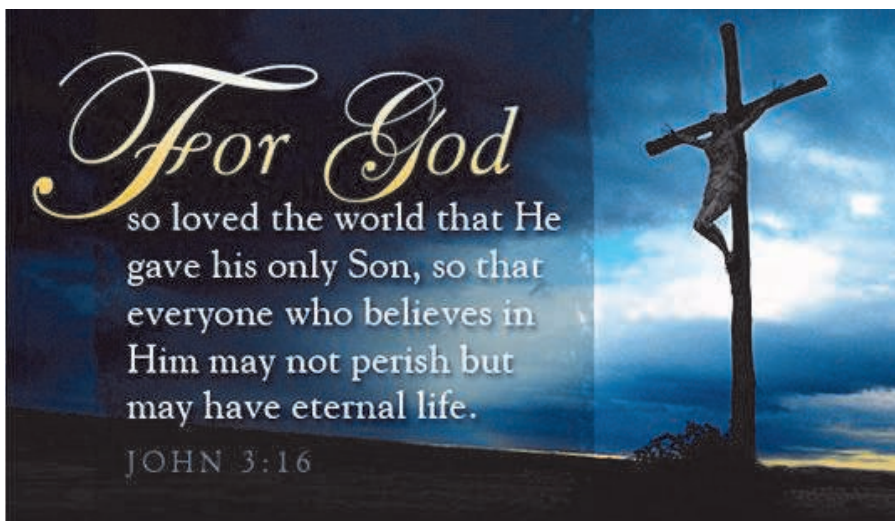

Our parish Council of Catholic Women is sponsoring a *Shoe Cutting Party* Thursday, March 15 at 6:30 pm in the parish hall at Saint Patrick Church, Lodi.

Supporting the work of *Sole Hope Organization*, our Shoe Cutting Party is a direct response to the need of the people of Uganda who suffer from a foot parasite called jiggers. During the party, we will trace shoe patterns, cut fabric and plastic pieces that will then be sent to Uganda, providing gainful employment to local shoe makers and tailors in that country. We will be part of a gesture of hope and healing that will provide closed toe shoes to protect the Uganda people from these terrible parasites that prevent children from going to school, running and playing, and adults from walking and working. Our goal is to make 10 sets of shoes during our evening together.

Here's what is needed for the party:

*YOU - your cheerful smile, willing heart, and helpful hands!

*Sharp fabric scissors

*Denim - from old blue jeans, etc.

Also appreciated, monetary donations to contribute toward the cost of shipping (\$10/pair of shoes) and the wages for the Ugandan shoemaker and tailor who will finish the shoes.
