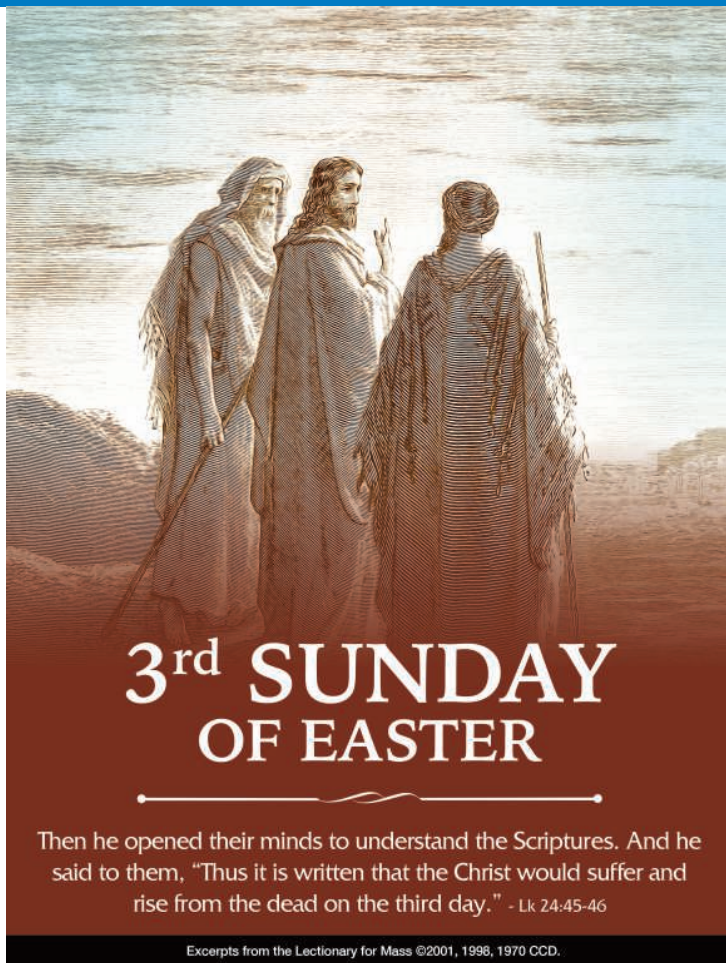

Held at Blessed Trinity School, Saint Michael Church, Dane, the Grade 1-5 program will be Monday to Friday, June 11-15 from 9:00 am to 2:30 pm. Daily Mass will be celebrated at 11:15 am. Registration Fee is \$25 per child with a Family Rate of \$70 for 3 or more children.

The Grade 6-8 program will be held Sunday to Thursday, June 10-14 from 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm. Registration fee per teen is \$15.

Daily sessions, offered by the *Totus Tuus* team of college students and seminarians, will engage youth with skits, songs, games and inspiring, interactive teaching on the basic tenets of the Catholic faith, cultivating both a firm intellectual grounding and a solid personal relationship with Christ. The summer 2018 program is dedicated to the Apostles Creed and the Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary.
